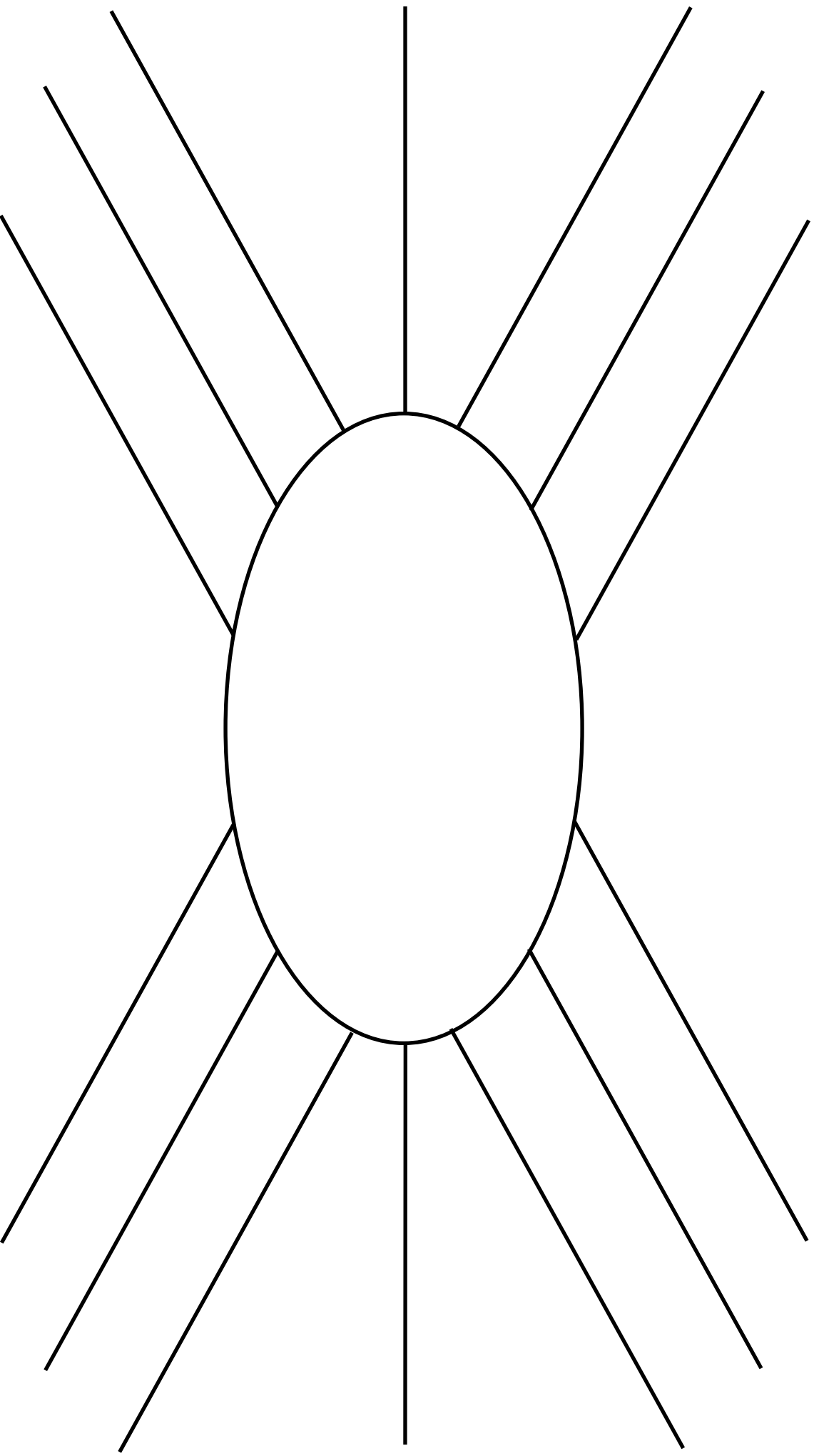


Your @Team Research Planning Diagram
